

- --<u>Key Concept</u>: Without taking the time to deal with the <u>DEPTHS</u> of Scripture related to Rapture timing...the view that you hold will either be a <u>PREFERENCE</u>...an <u>ASSUMPTION</u>...or a mere <u>BYPRODUCT</u> of your theological tradition!!!

--<u>Heilsgeschichte</u>

- --Heilsgeschichte: (English) → SALVATION history
 - --<u>Meaning</u>: A theological view that understands <u>ALL</u> of history...literally <u>EVERY</u> detail of history...to be an expression of God's <u>SAVING</u> history
- --<u>A fundamental biblical understanding of the nature of God…and the nature of history</u>: At His <u>essence</u>...God is <u>SAVIOR</u>...and at its <u>essence</u>...history is all about God <u>SAVING</u>
- --<u>Key Concept #1</u>: "Covenant" has no true <u>SYNONYM</u> in the English Language...because Covenant is actually an entire <u>CATEGORY</u> of <u>THOUGHT</u>!!!
- --Key Concept #2: Covenant is the biblical **EXPRESSION** of God's **SALVATION** History
- --<u>Key Concept #3</u>: If you don't understand the biblical <u>COVENANTS</u>...you won't understand God's perspective of <u>HISTORY</u>...or God's perspective of <u>SALVATION</u>

-- Understanding the Biblical Covenants:

- --Two kinds of biblical covenants:
 - -- UNIVERSAL Covenants: Adamic, Noahic, New Testament
 - -- JEWISH Covenants: Abrahamic, Mosaic, Davidic
- --<u>Key Concept</u>: While <u>ALL</u> of the Covenants are <u>Salvation</u> Covenants...a subset of them are <u>STRATEGIC</u> Salvation Covenants
- -- Two categories of STRATEGIC Salvation Covenants:
 - 1. The <u>JEWISH</u> Covenants (Abrahamic, Mosaic, Davidic)
 --Genesis 12: "In you I will bless all the families of the earth"
 - 2. The **NEW TESTAMENT** Covenant
- --<u>Covenant Precept #1</u>: The <u>purpose</u> of choosing <u>ABRAHAM</u>...was to provide a <u>STRATEGY</u> to take salvation to the <u>whole</u> world
- --<u>Covenant Precept #2</u>: The purpose of choosing the <u>CHURCH</u>...is to provide a <u>STRATEGY</u> to take salvation to the <u>whole</u> world

- --<u>A theological foundation regarding the Covenants</u>: The very <u>NATURE</u> of the <u>Strategic</u> Salvation Covenants...<u>PRECLUDES</u> them from being <u>CONCURRENT</u> plans to save the world
 - --<u>Key Concept</u>: There is no strategic <u>OVERLAP</u> of the <u>JEWISH</u> and <u>NEW</u> Testament Covenants
- --<u>Strength #6</u>: The Pre-Trib View perfectly <u>INTEGRATES</u> the Old and New <u>COVENANTS</u>... providing for <u>precise and complete fulfillment</u> of the promises both to <u>ISRAEL</u>...and to the <u>CHURCH</u>
 - --<u>Daniel 9:24-27 (excerpts)</u>: "<u>Seventy weeks</u> have been decreed for <u>your people</u>...Then <u>after</u> the sixty-two weeks the <u>Messiah will be cut off</u> and...and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary...And he will make a <u>firm covenant</u> with the many for <u>one week</u>..."
 - --How the Pre-Trib view explains "The Gap" in Daniel's sevens: The Covenants with Israel were "placed on HOLD"...while the Church filled the Gap with the New Testament Covenant...but the "HOLD" will be released when the Church vanishes...allowing for the Jewish Covenants to RESUME...and to be COMPLETED
- --<u>Application</u>: Since all of history is <u>SALVATION</u> History...<u>EVERY</u> aspect of our life should be about <u>SAVING!!!</u>
 - --<u>I Kings 10: 1-7, 10</u>: When the queen of Sheba heard about the fame of Solomon and his relationship to the Lord, she came to test Solomon with hard questions. Arriving at Jerusalem with a very great caravan—with camels carrying spices, large quantities of gold, and precious stones—she came to Solomon and talked with him about all that she had on her mind. Solomon answered all her questions; nothing was too hard for the king to explain to her. When the queen of Sheba saw <u>all the wisdom of Solomon</u> and <u>the palace he had built</u>, the <u>food</u> on his table, the <u>seating</u> of his officials, the <u>attending servants</u> in their robes, his <u>cupbearers</u>, and the <u>burnt offerings</u> he made at the temple of the Lord, she was overwhelmed. She said to the king, "The report I heard in my own country about <u>your achievements</u> and <u>your wisdom</u> is true. But I did not believe these things until I came and saw with my own eyes. Indeed, not even half was told me; <u>in wisdom and wealth you have far exceeded the report I heard</u>...And she gave the king 120 talents of <u>gold</u>, large quantities of <u>spices</u>, and <u>precious stones</u>. Never again were so many spices brought in as those the queen of Sheba gave to King Solomon...
 - --<u>I Kings 10:13</u>: King Solomon gave the queen of Sheba <u>all she desired and asked for</u>, besides what he had given her <u>out of his royal bounty</u>. <u>Then she left and returned with her retinue to her own country</u>.
 - --<u>What did Solomon forget</u>? The reason God gave him **EVERYTHING** he had...was to be used to take the message of **SALVATION**...to the **WORLD**!!!
 - --What did the Queen of Sheba get??? She <u>CAME</u> with riches and gifts and cool stuff...and she <u>LEFT</u> with riches and gifts and cool stuff!!!
 - --<u>Key Question</u>: Am I <u>SQUANDERING</u> <u>any</u> of the positions or possessions or relationships or resources or time or opportunities that God has given <u>me</u>...on the <u>LOWLY</u>, <u>TEMPORARY</u> things of this world???
 - --Covenant is an entire <u>CATEGORY</u> of <u>THOUGHT</u>...Covenant is <u>a way of thinking</u>...it's an entire construct of reality. → Covenant...is a way of life!!!
 - --<u>Key Question</u>: When <u>MY</u> history is finally written...will it be a "Heilsgeschichte"...a <u>SALVATION</u> history...or will it be a history that's all about...<u>ME</u>???!!!
