- -- The Pre-Tribulational Rapture—The Strengths:
- --<u>Strength #1</u>: It <u>RESOLVES</u> the dramatic <u>DIFFERENCES</u> between the <u>EVENTS</u> described in the Rapture passages and the 2nd Coming passages
- --<u>Strength #2</u>: The Pre-Trib View is supported by the <u>BEST</u> Revelation picture of the Rapture...and makes perfect sense of the presence of the <u>VOICE</u>...and the <u>TRUMPET</u>...in the Rapture passages --<u>I Thess 4:15-17</u>: "For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a <u>shout</u>, with the voice of the archangel and with the <u>trumpet</u> of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be <u>caught</u> up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air..."
 - --What I Thessalonians 4 describes: 1) A SHOUT, 2) A TRUMPET, 3) Believers are CAUGHT up, 4) They MEET the Lord
 - --Four specific aspects of the Rapture sequence:
 - 3. The Lord will <u>SHOUT</u> a loud command as He <u>DESCENDS</u> (I Thess 4:16)
 - 4. We will hear the VOICE of the ARCHANGEL (I Thess 4:16)
 - 5. We will hear the TRUMPET call of God (I Thess 4:16)
 - 9. The <u>LIVING</u> saints will be <u>CAUGHT</u> up to meet the Lord (I Thess 4:17)
- --<u>An example of an approach to unpacking the Rapture</u>: The "loud <u>VOICE</u>"...and the "<u>TRUMPET</u>"...have very specific biblical meanings and usages that can help us <u>EVALUATE</u> the 3 Rapture Timing Views
 - --The meaning and purpose of the shout of the Lord:
 - --The shout at **BETHANY**
 - --<u>John 11:43-44</u>: When He had said these things, He <u>cried out with a loud voice</u>, "Lazarus, come forth." And <u>the man who had died came forth</u>, bound hand and foot with wrappings, and his face was wrapped around with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Unbind him, and let him go."
 - --The shout at **CALVARY**
 - --<u>Matt 27:50-53</u>: And <u>Jesus cried out again with a loud voice</u>, and yielded up His spirit. And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom; and the earth shook and the rocks were split. And the tombs were opened, <u>and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised; and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection they entered the holy city and appeared to many.</u>
 - -- The shout at the RAPTURE
 - --I Thess 4:16: For <u>the Lord Himself</u> will descend from heaven <u>with a shout</u>, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, <u>and the dead in Christ will rise</u> first.
 - --John 5:25, 28-29: "Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, <u>when the</u> <u>dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live</u>...Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which <u>all who are in the tombs will hear His voice</u>, <u>and will come forth</u>..."
 - --<u>Key Concept</u>: When the Lord <u>SHOUTS</u> with a loud <u>VOICE</u>...it literally <u>raises</u> the <u>DEAD!!!</u>

-- The meaning and purpose of the trumpet:

- -- Purpose #1: The trumpet is a CALL to BATTLE
 - --<u>Numbers 10:9</u>: When you go to <u>war</u> in your land against the adversary who attacks you, then you shall <u>sound an alarm with the trumpets</u>, that you may be remembered before the Lord your God, and be saved from your enemies.
 - --<u>Numbers 31:6</u>: Moses sent them, a thousand from each tribe, <u>to the war</u>, and Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, <u>to the war</u> with them...and the <u>trumpets for the alarm</u> in his hand.

-- Purpose #2: The trumpet is a CALL to WORSHIP

- --<u>II Chronicles 5:13</u>: "...in unison when the <u>trumpeters</u> and the singers were to make themselves heard with one voice <u>to praise and to glorify the Lord</u>, and when they lifted up their voice accompanied by <u>trumpets</u> and cymbals and instruments of music, and when <u>they praised the Lord</u> saying, "He indeed is good for His lovingkindness is everlasting," then the house, the house of the Lord, was filled with a cloud,"
- --<u>II Chronicles 29:28</u>: "...the whole assembly <u>worshiped</u>, the singers also sang and *the trumpets sounded*..."

--Summary:

- -- The purpose of the voice of the Lord at the Rapture: To RAISE the DEAD!!!
- --<u>The purpose of the trumpet at the Rapture</u>: Calling the Church to **WORSHIP** in **HEAVEN**

-- A scoring approach to evaluating the Rapture:

- --Scoring method: 0 = Not a match; 1 = Possible/inferred match; 2 = Good match
 - --<u>I Thess 4:16-17</u>: "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a <u>shout</u>, with the voice of the archangel and with the <u>trumpet</u> of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be <u>caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air</u>..."

--Scoring the Post-Trib View:

- --Rev 19:16-17: And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS." Then I saw an <u>angel</u> standing in the sun, and <u>he cried out with a loud voice</u>, saying to all the birds which fly in midheaven, "Come, assemble for the great supper of God so that you may eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of commanders and the flesh of mighty men…"
- --<u>Matt 24:30-31</u>: And then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of the sky with power and great glory. And He will send forth His angels with <u>a great trumpet</u> and they will <u>gather together His elect</u> from the four winds, from one end of the sky to the other.

--Scoring the Mid-Trib View:

--Rev 11:3, 6-9, 11-12: And I will grant authority to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for *twelve hundred and sixty days*, clothed in sackcloth."...These have the power to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall during the days of their prophesying; and they have power over the waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague...When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and *kill* them. And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city...where also their Lord was crucified. Those from the peoples and tribes and tongues and nations will look at their dead bodies for three and a half days, and will not permit their dead bodies to be laid in a tomb...But after the three and a half days, *the breath of life from God came into them, and they stood on their feet*...And they heard *a loud voice* from heaven saying to them, "Come up here." Then they went up into heaven...

--<u>Vv. 15-16</u>: Then the seventh angel <u>sounded</u>; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever." And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and <u>worshiped God</u>...

--Scoring the Pre-Trib View:

--Rev 4:1-2: After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and the first <u>voice</u> which I had heard, like the sound of a <u>trumpet</u> speaking with me, said, "<u>Come up</u> <u>here</u>, and I will show you what must take place after these things." Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne was standing in <u>heaven</u>, and <u>One</u> sitting on the throne.

--<u>Vv. 4, 10</u>: Around the throne were twenty-four thrones; and upon the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white garments, and golden crowns on their heads...and the twenty-four elders will fall down before Him who sits on the throne, and will <u>worship</u> Him who lives forever and ever...

--What Revelation 4 describes:

--1) A loud <u>VOICE</u>, 2) A <u>TRUMPET</u>, 3) John is <u>CAUGHT</u> up, 4) He's <u>WITH</u> the Lord 5) He joins those in heaven in <u>WORSHIP</u>

--Rev 1:12-13, 17: Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands; and in the middle of the lampstands I saw one like a son of man...and when I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man.

--<u>Rev 4:1</u>: After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and the first <u>voice</u> which I had heard, like the sound of a <u>trumpet</u> speaking with me, said, "<u>Come up here</u>...

-- A Summary:

- --Key Concept #1: Determining Rapture TIMING is COMPLEX!!!
- -- Key Concept #2: NONE of the views matches the Rapture passages PERFECTLY!!!
- --<u>Key Concept #3</u>: In this specific analysis of the texts...the <u>PRE</u>-Trib Rapture view fares **WELL**
- --<u>Key Concept #4</u>: At least in these passages...the Word hasn't revealed enough **DETAIL** to be absolutely **SURE** of which timing view is **BEST**!!!

--Application: The greatest POWER in the Universe...is the VOICE of God!!!

--Key Concept #1: With a WORD...God RAISES the DEAD!!!

--Gen 1:3, 6, 9, 11, 14-15, 20, 24, 26: Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light...Then God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters...Then God said, "Let the waters below the heavens be gathered into one place, and let the dry land appear"; and it was so...Then God said, "Let the earth sprout vegetation, plants yielding seed, and fruit trees on the earth bearing fruit after their kind with seed in them"; and it was so...Then God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night...and let them be for lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so...Then God said, "Let the waters teem with swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth in the open expanse of the heavens."...and God saw that it was good...Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth living creatures after their kind: cattle and creeping things and beasts of the earth after their kind"; and it was so...Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness..."

--Key Concept #2: With a WORD...God creates EVERYTHING...from NOTHING!!!

--<u>II Thess 2:1-3, 8</u>: Now we request you, brethren, with regard to <u>the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him</u>, that you not be quickly shaken from your composure or be disturbed either by a spirit or a message or a letter as if from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come. Let no one in any way deceive you, for it will not come unless the apostasy comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction...Then that lawless one will be revealed <u>whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth</u> and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming...

- --Key Concept #3: With a WORD...God will DEFEAT the ENEMY!!!
- -- The Biblical Power Precepts:
 - --Power Precept #1: TIMELESSNESS cannot stand against the word of God!!!
 - --<u>Power Precept #2</u>: The <u>VOID</u> of <u>NOTHINGNESS</u> cannot stand against the <u>word</u> of God!!!
 - --Power Precept #3: DARKNESS cannot stand against the word of God!!!
 - --Power Precept #4: **DEATH** cannot stand against the *word* of God!!!
 - --Power Precept #5: **SATAN** cannot stand against the *word* of God!!!
