Regarding the Approval of the Government's Action Plan for 2020–2023

The Government DECIDES:

- 1.** The Government Action Plan for 2020-2023 is approved (annexed).
- 2.** Ministries and other central administrative authorities:
 - 1) will take the necessary measures for the full execution and within the established deadlines of the Government Action Plan for the years 2020-2023;
 - 2) will submit quarterly, until the 5th of the following month of the reporting quarter, the information on the execution of the nominated Plan, using the governmental platform for reporting, evaluation and monitoring "PlanPro" (<http://monitorizare.gov.md>);
 - 3) they will present annually, to the State Chancellery, until February 1, the information on the achievement of the objectives and progress indicators of the mentioned Plan, according to the areas of competence.
- 3.** The State Chancellery will present to the Government:
 - 1) until the 15th of the following month of the reporting quarter, the information regarding the progress in the Implement the mentioned above Plan for the previous quarter;
 - 2) until March 1, the evaluation report of the Implement the mentioned above Plan for the previous year.
- 4.** The State Chancellery together with the ministries and other central administrative authorities will ensure the annual update of the nominated Plan.

The control over the execution of this decision is the responsibility of the State Chancellery.

5. The Government Decision no. 420/2019 regarding the Approve the Government Action Plan for the years 2019-2020 is repealed (Monitorul Oficial of the Republic of Moldova, 2019, no. 281-288, art. 618).

6. This decision shall enter into force on the date of its publication.
