Caterpillar Crawl Clues

- 1. Welcome to the caterpillar crawl, we really hope you find them all! We know you're ready for some fun, so let us start with number one. At the Farmer's Market is where to look, near the mural on his book.

- 10. Take a left at Cumberland and head up the block to a place for a coffee and macaroon. Our caterpillar friend has changed quite a bit and is now in a cocoon.
