
Coming soon: when you call the Middle School, there will be an option for all your technology questions, problems, or concerns.

A Message from the Sanford Backpack Program



In the event that the Sanford School district pivots to "Fully Remote Learning" The Sanford Backpack Program is prepared to continue serving the Sanford students and their families.

Our plan is to still be able to access school pantry rooms weekly for gathering of supplies to offer pantry staples as well as fresh produce, meats, and dairy. Rather than holding our distributions at dismissals at SHS and SMS, we are prepared to offer weekly food distributions as we did beginning back in March and throughout the summer. These will be curbside pick-ups of prepacked food boxes open to all Sanford Springvale residents, but we hope to really

target our school families.

If the "fully remote" decision is made, The Sanford Backpack Program will hold FREE food distributions every Thursday from 4:00-6:00 pm (or until we run out) at both Willard School and Lafayette School. Follow our Facebook page for updates and any changes in time or locations.

If you know of students who would benefit from our service but are not sure they have access to transportation for the distributions, please reach out to them and see if a delivery is something they would

need. If we can gather the addresses of those in need without means of transport we will do our best with the help of volunteers and possibly SROs to deliver food to those in need.
