ㅜ – u – u (ওঠ) *sounds like [woo]

ㅡ – eu – eu (ওঠ)

ㅣ – i – i (ଓঠ) *sounds like [e]

ㅑ – ya – ya (ଓঠ)

ㅓ – yeo – yeo (ଓঠ) *sounds like [yuh]

ঔ – yo – yo (ওঠ)

উ – yu – yu (ওঠ) *sounds like [you]
