Internship summary

GRI is looking to recruit an intern interested in sustainability, to support research, outreach, and engagement activity in the North America region. The internship is to begin in the first quarter of 2023 for a period of 6 months on a full- or part-time basis with a possibility of an extension of 3 months.

This internship will provide ample learning opportunities and access to asynchronous on-demand courses available through the [GRI Academy](#) including a pathway to gain the [GRI Certified Sustainability Professional credential](#).

Tasks

- Support GRI's North America team, including but not limited to the following tasks:
- Liaise with the Amsterdam-based colleagues and US colleagues regarding GRI Community account management, outreach, and administration
- Support regional leadership with tasks related to promotion and execution of GRI sustainability reporting support offerings that include the GRI Academy, GRI Services and GRI Community
- Detailed research and lead identification to grow GRI's impact in North America through development of our network/client base
- Liaise with Headquarters regarding resource offerings and standards development
- Assist with different research projects, events and any ad hoc tasks that may arise such as:
 - Develop and execute strategic communications plans and campaigns specifically for North America Region on social media
 - Engage with media stakeholders to raise awareness of the value of GRI standards
 - Ensure alignment and consistent messaging across our external engagements

- Fluent in written and spoken English, French and Spanish language is a plus
- Excellent research and social media skills (*Preferred*)
- Detail-oriented - accuracy and thoroughness are of the greatest importance
- Ability to work with individuals from a range of different backgrounds and various levels of management

We do this through the creation of a global common language for organizations to report their sustainability impacts. This enables informed dialogue and decision-making around those impacts.

GRI is the global standard setter for impact reporting, which through an independent, multi-stakeholder process, maintains the world's most comprehensive set of sustainability reporting standards. Available as a free public good in 12 languages, the GRI Standards are, globally, the most widely used for sustainability reporting.



More than 10,000 organizations, including 78% of the largest 250 companies in the world, disclose sustainability information through the GRI Standards – something unimaginable only 25 years ago. In addition, our standards are referenced explicitly in 160 policies of governments, regulators, and stock exchanges in 60 countries.
