## Splash Pad Rules

#### Hours of Operation - 9am-Dusk

- The splashpad is not a supervised area. Use at your own risk.
- Parent or guardian must supervise children at all times.
- Do not climb, hang, swing or pull on the splash pad equipment.
- Children that require diapers must wear swim diapers.
- No street shoes on splash pad. Appropriate swim attire recommended.
- Persons with infectious diseases, open cuts or sores are not permitted.
- No food, drinks or glass containers permitted in the splash pad.
- No scooters, roller blades, bicycles or skateboards allowed.
- Splash pad may be closed at any time for maintenance or other concerns.
- Stay off area where grass is beginning to grow.
- Do not use splash pad during serve weather conditions.
- Be courteous to others and abide by all park rules.
- Spray water is chlorinated. Do not drink.
- No animals allowed on the splash pad.
- Recreational use only. No bathing.
- No running or rough play.
- Having fun is strongly encouraged.

### How It Works

To activate the play features during hours of operation, press the button on top of the red posts. Once activated, the sequence of features will run for four minutes. Once complete, the activator button must be pressed again to begin a new sequence for four more minutes. Repeat!
