TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves wrap up a sixgame road series against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field on Sunday. This is the first of two series between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 12 times (return trip, June 20-25).

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The M-Braves were held without a hit until Saturday's eighth inning, rallying for a run in a 1-0 win to take a 3-2 series edge. Starter Luis De Avila delivered a season-best six shutout innings on one hit with four walks, and seven strikeouts. Relievers Alex Segal, Coleman Huntley III, and Victor Vodnik combined with De Avila for the four-hit shutout.

SCORING BARRAGE: Despite just one run on Saturday, the M-Braves have scored 52 runs, including eight home runs in their last seven games. The 52 runs rank 3rd in Double-A since May 27.

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens is 8-for-16 with two doubles, two home runs, and eight RBI in the last four games. The 25-year-old had a double, and homer in Wednesday's sixth inning.

ROLLIN' WITH ROBLES: The 24-year-old lefty ranks 2nd in the league with a 2.32 ERA, and ranks among the leaders in wins (T-3rd, 4), strikeouts (T-10th, 57), opponents' average (T-6th, .213), and WHIP (3rd, 1.08).

TURNING THE SHIP AROUND: Despite having the second-worst record in the league at 23-26, the M-Braves are 14-8 since May 9. The club is 20-16 since April 22 after starting the season at 3-10 with an eight-game losing streak. After losing four of the first five series this season, the M-Braves swept Chattanooga in a five-game series at Trustmark Park from May 9-14, outscoring the Lookouts 27-8, and split the last two series against Montgomery and Pensacola.

THIS TEAM KNOWS HOW TO PITCH: The M-Braves pitching staff has been one of the best in minor league baseball this season. The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching, are 2nd in Double-A, and 8th in MiLB with a 3.51 ERA

The M-Braves finished May with the fourthbest ERA in MiLB at 2.99.

<u>"KISS IT GOODBYE", BUT NOT AT TRUSTMARK</u> PARK: The M-Braves have hit 48 homers - 36 coming on the road. 12 different players have at least one homer with Drew Lugbauer leading the way with 10 homers, ranking 2nd in the Southern League. Lugbauer has four of the club's 12 home runs at Trustmark Park

M-Braves opponents have just six home runs at Trustmark Park this season, all by Montgomery from April 18-23.

SMITH-SHAWVER TO THE BIGS: The Atlanta Braves promoted RHP AJ Smith-Shawver to the major league roster on Tuesday. When Smith-Shawver makes his MLB debut he will become the fourth M-Braves alum to debut this season, ioining INF Braden Shewmake. (5/5). LHP Dvlan Dodd (4/4), and LHP Jared Shuster (4/2), and 165th since 2005.

PROSPECTING: Six of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

VALDES STREAK ENDS AT 19: Javier Valdes saw his team-best 19-game on-base streak, which began on April 23, end on Friday night. Over the streak, the Miami, FL native hit .361 with five doubles, five home runs, nine RBI, 16 walks, and 1.189 OPS. He also had a team-high eightgame hit streak, which began on May 18.

THE DEAN OF THE CLASS: Justin Dean has caught fire, and is batting .393, with 10 runs, eight walks, and .528 OBP.

OTHER STREAKS ...: Luke Waddell, and Jesse Franklin V are on six-game hit streaks. Waddell is batting .320, while Franklin is batting .348 over the streaks

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever allowed a run for the first time on May 20 in his 12th relief appearance. He has four saves (T-2nd, SL). Barger started the season with 15 shutout innings, with 19 strikeouts to seven walks, in 11 appearances. He currently has a 1.71 ERA in 20 innings.

COUNTIN' ON CONLEY: M-Braves leadoff hitter Cal Conley has reached base in 20 of his last 23 games. Since moving to the leadoff spot, Conley raised his batting average from .213 to .237. When leading off an inning, he's batting .302 with one home run. Conley ranks 4th in the league with 17 stolen bases.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer homered in three straight games from Tues-day-Thursday, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. Lugbauer achieved the feat from July 25-28 in 2021. He has reached base in 14 of the last 15 games.

The first baseman ranks among the league leaders in home runs (10, 2nd), SLG (.545, 1st), OPS (.893, 4th), RBI (32, T-4th), and XBH (20, T-6th).

Lugbauer recorded his first career M-Braves triple on May 13 against the Lookouts, then another on May 16 at Montgomery. He made his profesional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscol on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-perhour home run, which would rank 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls this season.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 56 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox pitched one shutout inning on Friday. He has et to allow a run in 9.1 innings over seven relief appearances with the M-Braves, including one walk to 16 strikeouts.

The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

FAMILIAR FACE: Barons OF Tyler Neslony played in 245 games for Mississippi from 2017-2021. In 13 games against his former team, Atlanta's 9thround pick in 2016, is batting .383 (20-for-52) with eight doubles, three home runs, and 11 RBI.




