TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame road series on Friday night against the Biloxi Shuckers at MGM Park.

BATTLE AT THE BEACH: The M-Braves and Shuckers meet for the fourth of six series' through Monday at MGM Park. The M-Braves went 7-8 against the Shuckers in the first-half, including 3-3 at MGM Park. This is the first of two series' during the second half, with the final set being August 15-20, at Trustmark Park.

Drew Lugbauer has a .357 average, five home runs, three doubles, and 10 RBI in 12 games vs. Biloxi this season. Over his career, Lugbauer is batting .247 (56-for-227) with 13 doubles, 22 (13 at MGM Park) home runs, and 58 RBI in 62 games.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves battled back from a 4-0 deficit, getting home runs from Luke Waddell, and Drew Lugbauer, but fell eventually 7-6 to suffer a fifth-straight loss. Cade Bunnell reached base safely four times, going 2-for-3 with two walks, a run, and RBI. Starter Scott Bluewett gave up four runs over 3.2 innings in a no-decision.

LET THE GOOD TIMES ROLL: Over the last seven series' of the first half, the club went 3-1-3, including a five-game sweep of Chattanooga from May 9-14 and a series win over Pensacola from June 13-18. The M-Braves closed the first half by going 24-17 over the last 41 games, after starting 9-18.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching, are 3rd in Double-A, and 15th in MiLB with a 3.76 ERA. The M-Braves finished May with the fourth best ERA in MiLB at 2.99

<u>GRAND SALAMI TIME:</u> Less than halfway through the season, the M-Braves have a club record four grand slams, including the first ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell).

The M-Braves hit 17 home runs this past week, their most in a series this season. The club hit 10 homers from April 25-30 at Biloxi.

PROSPECTING: 7 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), RHP Tanner Gordon (28), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

HOME RUN ADVANTAGE AT HOME FIELD: The M-Braves rank third in the league with 82 homers - 50 on the road while their opponents have just 53 total home runs, which is 2nd in Double-A. 16 different players have at least one homer with Landon Stephens and Drew Lugbauer leading the way with 13, ranking 2nd in the Southern League.

The M-Braves have 32 home runs at home and hit 12 home runs at Trustmark Park from June 6-11 vs Biloxi. M-Braves opponents have just 13 home runs at Trustmark Park this season

STREAKIN' TOLVE: Tyler Tolve increased his onbase streak to 19 games (began May 24) with two walks on Wednesday. Over the streak, Tolve is slashing .280/.353/.387 with two home runs, two doubles, nine walks, and 12 RBI. he streak matches Javier Valdes' 19 game on-base streak, from April 23-June 1.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer was reinstated from the Injured List Tuesday, after being placed on it on June 14 with a mild hamstring strain. On Thursday, Lugbauer hit his 100th minor league home run, which was his 59th in three seasons for the M-Braves. Lugbauer ranks among the league leaders in home runs (13, T-2nd), RBI (39, T-10th), SLG (.610, 1st), OPS (.996, 2nd), OBP (.386, 6th) and XBH (26, 6th). He is currently on a 10-game hitting streak, batting .455 with 4 2B, 3 HR, 8 RBI, 6 BB, .538 OBP, and 1.386 OBP. It's the longest current streak in the league.

LEAGUE AFFILIATE OF THE

Lugbauer homered in three straight games from May 23-25, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. Lugbauer achieved the feat from July 25-28, 2021

Lugbauer made his professional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscoll on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-per-hour home run, which ranked 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls at the time.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 59 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011), Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell is tied for T-2nd in the league with 30 hits in June, batting .313 with a .407 OBP.

**DE AVILA DELIVERS IN JUNE:** Luis De Avila has delivered four solid starts in June, going 2-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 22.1 innings. The left-hander ranks top 10 in the league in ERA (3.03, 2nd), IP (59.1, 10th), OPP AVG (.208, 4th), and WHIP (1.26, 7th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens homered in three straight games from June 16-18 to propel himself into second in the league with 13 homers. He is the eighth M-Brave all-time to homer in three straight. Stephens has seven homers and is slugging .589 over 21 games in June.

HOT VOD: Victor Vodnik has vet to allow a run in 13.0 innings over eight appearances. Since the start of May, Vodnik has a 0.77 ERA in 23.1 innings over 16 appearances with 13 walks to 36 strikeouts. He is currently T-2nd in the league appearances with 24.

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox has allowed two earned runs in 17.2 innings over 16 relief appearances with the M-Braves, including eight walks to 25 strikeouts. The right-hander was on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings.

RETURN OF THE DEAN: Justin Dean comes back to the M-Braves after spending June 9-18 with Triple-A Gwinnett. In his first game back on Wednesday, Dean smashed a line drive off the right field wall and sped around the bases for an inside the park home run.

#### **TODAY'S GAME**

Luis De Avila makes his 14th start, and his third career start against Biloxi. De Avila has a 1.61 ERA over four June starts, including 4.0 shutout innings on June 9 vs. Biloxi. De Avila ranks 2nd in the league with a 3.03 ERA, 4th in opponents' batting average, .208, and 8th in WHIP, 1.26.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

De Avila tossed a season-high 6.1 innings of one-run ball, earning the win in Mississippi's 6-1 victory over Birmingham last Thursday at Trustmark Park. The 22-year-old struck out six, and walked three, yielding four hits.
