




Installation Preparation



• The rough cabinet opening must be at least 24" deep. The opening should be 35" max. height.

- The dishwasher must be installed so that drain hose is no more than 10 feet in length for proper drainage.
- The dishwasher must be fully enclosed on the top, sides and back, and must not support any part of the enclosure.

CLEARANCES: When installed into a corner, allow 2" min. clearance between dishwasher and adjacent cabinet, wall or other appliances. Allow 25-5/8" min. clearance from the front of the dishwasher for door opening. Figure B



DRAIN REQUIREMENTS

- Follow local codes and ordinances.
- Do not exceed 10 feet distance to drain.
- Do not connect drain lines from other devices to the dishwasher drain hose.
- Dishwasher must be connected to waste line with an air gap (not supplied) or 32" minimum high drain loop, depending on local codes and ordinances to prevent back flow into the dishwasher.
- Air gap must be used if waste tee or disposer connection is less than 18" above the floor to prevent siphoning.

ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS

- This appliance must be supplied with 120V, 60Hz., and connected to an individual properly grounded branch circuit, protected by a 15 or 20 ampere circuit breaker or time delay fuse.
- Wiring must be 2 wire with ground.
