

 - --Chapter 1: Establishes Christ's awesome **SOVEREIGNTY**...and that He's coming **QUICKLY**!!!
 - --Chapters 2-3 (excerpts): "To the angel of the <u>church</u> in Ephesus write: The One who holds the seven stars in His right hand, the One who walks among the seven golden lampstands, says this... 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the <u>churches</u>'... And to the angel of the <u>churches</u>'... And to the angel of the <u>church</u> in Pergamum write... 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the <u>churches</u>'... And to the angel of the <u>churches</u>' in Thyatira write... 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the <u>churches</u>'... To the angel of the <u>churches</u>'... And to the angel of the <u>church</u> in Sardis write: 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the <u>churches</u>'... And to the angel of the <u>church</u> in Philadelphia write... 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the <u>churches</u>'... To the angel of the <u>church</u> in Laodicea write... 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the <u>churches</u>'... To the angel of the <u>churches</u>'...
 - --<u>The theme</u>: Chs 2 & 3 are <u>all</u> about The <u>CHURCH</u>...written to seven specific local <u>CHURCHES</u>...and they give a prophetic outline of the <u>CHURCH</u> Age
 - --4:1-2: After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven, and the first <u>voice</u> which I had heard, like the sound of a <u>trumpet</u> speaking with me, said, "<u>Come up here</u>, and I will show you what must take place after these things." Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne was standing in <u>heaven</u>, and <u>One</u> sitting on the throne.
 - -- Chapter 4 gives a picture of the PRE-Trib Rapture
 - --Rev. 5:1-4: "I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a book written inside and on the back, sealed up with seven seals. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the book and to break its seals?" And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the book or to look into it. Then I began to weep greatly because no one was found worthy to open the book or to look into it..."
 - --Having been **CAUGHT** up into **HEAVEN** to be with Christ in Ch 4...Ch 5 now gives a picture of the Judgment of **BELIEVERS**
 - --<u>6:1-2</u>: Then I saw when <u>the Lamb broke one of the seven seals</u>, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come." I looked, and behold, a white horse, and he who sat on it had <u>a bow</u>; and a crown was given to him, and he <u>went out conquering</u> <u>and to conquer</u>.

- --<u>In chapter 6</u>: The Tribulation <u>BEGINS</u> with the appearance of the <u>FAKE</u> "messiah"...who comes with a <u>FAKE</u> peace...to "save" <u>ISRAEL</u>
- --<u>Chs 6-18</u> (excerpts): And I heard the number of those who were sealed, one hundred and forty-four thousand sealed from every tribe of the sons of <u>Israel</u>: from the tribe of <u>Judah</u>, twelve thousand were sealed, from the tribe of <u>Reuben</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Gad</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Manasseh</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Simeon</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Levi</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Issachar</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Zebulun</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Joseph</u> twelve thousand, from the tribe of <u>Benjamin</u>, twelve thousand were sealed...
- --Then there was given me a measuring rod like a staff; and someone said, "Get up and measure <u>the temple of God and the altar</u>, and those who worship in it. Leave out the court which is outside the <u>temple</u> and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; and they will tread under foot <u>the holy city</u> for forty-two months...
- --And a great sign appeared in heaven: a <u>woman</u> clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars...and she was with child...And <u>she gave birth to a son...who is to rule all the nations</u>...Then the <u>woman</u> fled into the wilderness where <u>she had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished</u> for one thousand two hundred and sixty days...
- --And when the dragon saw that he was thrown down to the earth, he persecuted <u>the woman</u> <u>who gave birth to the male child</u>. But the two wings of the great eagle were given to the <u>woman</u>, so that she could fly into the wilderness to her place, where she was nourished for a time and times and half a time...And the serpent poured water like a river out of his mouth after the <u>woman</u>...But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and drank up the river which the dragon poured out of his mouth. So the dragon was enraged with the <u>woman</u>, and went off to make war with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.
- --Then I looked, and behold, the Lamb was standing on <u>Mount Zion</u>, and with Him <u>one hundred and forty-four thousand</u>, having His name and the name of His Father written on their foreheads...And they sang a new song before the throne...and no one could learn the song except the *one hundred and forty-four thousand* who had been purchased from the earth.
- --And I saw something like a sea of glass mixed with fire, and those who had been victorious over the beast...And they sang *the song of Moses*, the bond-servant of God...
- --And I saw coming out of the mouth of the dragon and out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet, three unclean spirits...which go out to the kings of the whole world, to gather them together for the war of the great day of God, the Almighty...And they gathered them together to the place which in Hebrew is called <u>Har-Magedon</u>.
 - --<u>Key Concept #1</u>: The Scripture <u>frequently</u> refers to <u>ISRAEL</u> (and Mary...who was a direct descendant of King David) giving <u>birth</u> to The Christ...but never even <u>HINTS</u> at the <u>CHURCH</u> giving birth to Him
 - --<u>Key Concept #2</u>: The Church is always pictured as the <u>BRIDE</u> of Christ...that was <u>ESTABLISHED</u> by Christ
 - --A summary of chapters 6-18: A <u>striking</u> and <u>complete</u> <u>ABSENCE</u> of the <u>Church</u>...and a repeated, pervasive <u>PROMINENCE</u> of <u>Israel</u>

--Ch 19: Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and *His bride* has made herself ready. And it was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the *saints*....Then he said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb."...And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war... And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, were following Him on white horses. From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations...And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet...these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.

--What happens in chapter 19: Christ returns WITH the SAINTS from Heaven...to the Valley of Megiddo...in ISRAEL...fulfilling God's many promises to save the CHOSEN Nation!!!

- -- A summary of the appearances of the Church in the Revelation:
 - --How many times does the word "*church*" appear in chapters 2 & 3? **SEVEN**
 - --How many times does the word "<u>churches</u>" appear in chapters 2 & 3? **EIGHT**
 - --How many times do the words "church" or "churches" appear in all of the rest of Revelation? → Not ONCE!!!
 - --<u>The final appearance of The Church in Revelation</u>: In chapter 19...<u>AFTER</u> the Tribulation is over...the <u>BRIDE</u> comes <u>FROM</u> Heaven...<u>WITH</u> Christ...to join Him in <u>CONQUERING</u> the Antichrist and his armies at Armageddon
- --<u>The Pre-Trib advocates' contention about the Book of Revelation</u>: It's difficult to **IMAGINE** how the biblical text could make it any **CLEARER**...that the sequence of the major events of the Last Days points to a **PRE**-Trib Rapture.
- --<u>The Sequence</u>: →
 - --John introduces Jesus' prophecy of His **RETURN** (Ch 1)
 - --The <u>CHURCH</u> Age runs its course in chapters 2 & 3...it comes to <u>COMPLETION</u>...and believers are <u>CAUGHT</u> up to be with Christ in Ch 4
 - --After the <u>CHURCH</u> is <u>gone</u>...the Tribulation <u>BEGINS</u> with <u>Israel's</u> Peace Treaty (Ch 6)
 - --The next seven years is about Antichrist's world **DOMINATION**...and his attempt to destroy **ISRAEL** (Chs 6-18)
 - --The Church isn't mentioned <u>AGAIN</u> until the Tribulation is <u>OVER</u>...and this means that the Church does not live **THROUGH** the Tribulation
 - --The Tribulation <u>ENDS</u> after seven years...when Christ returns from Heaven...<u>with</u> the <u>SAINTS</u>...and saves <u>ISRAEL</u> from annihilation at Armageddon (Ch 19)

--Dave Hunt:

--"The Book of Revelation is a clear description of the Pre-Trib Rapture timing. Chapters 2 and 3 are <u>all about the church!</u> Then, at the end of chapter 3, the Church Age comes to <u>completion</u>...just in time for John (a member of the Church) to hear a loud voice, and a trumpet, and then to be <u>caught up</u> into heaven in chapter 4. This is followed by John, representing the Church, standing before the Judgment Seat of Christ as he is purified...made perfectly holy...by the Blood of the Lamb in chapter 5. And then the Church <u>vanishes</u> from the Book...not to be heard from again, until Christ comes (in chapter 19) with His holy ones...to defeat Antichrist and win the Battle of Armageddon. So, the Pre-Trib chronology in Revelatoin is natural, simple, and flows directly out of the Scripture...without any manipulation and without laying any other system over the biblical text.

--<u>Application</u>: Do <u>you</u> love God's <u>CHOSEN</u> People <u>ISRAEL</u>...like <u>God</u> loves them???

--<u>Gen 12:1-3</u>: Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go forth from your country, and from your relatives and from your father's house, to the land which I will show you; and I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and so you shall be a blessing; and <u>I</u> will bless those who bless you, and the one who curses you I will curse. --<u>An obvious question</u>: If I actually <u>BELIEVE</u> God's promise...how can <u>I</u> bless God's <u>CHOSEN</u> People...in a <u>TANGIBLE</u> way???
