

--<u>Purpose #5</u>: It reminds us to be ______...and _____!!! --<u>Matt. 24:37-41, 44-51</u>: For the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah. For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and they did not understand until the flood came and took them all away; so will the coming of the Son of Man be. Then there will be two men in the field; one will be taken and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken and one will be left...For this reason you also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think <u>He will</u>. "Who then is the faithful and sensible slave whom his master put in charge of his household to give them their food at the proper time? Blessed is that slave whom his master finds so doing when he comes. Truly I say to you that he will put him in charge of all his possessions. But if that evil slave says in his heart, 'My master is not coming for a long time,' and begins to beat his fellow slaves and eat and drink with drunkards; *the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour which he does not know*, and will cut him in pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

<u>Thursology 77: Did Jesus FAKE the Resurrection???</u> <u>The Passover Plot & the Stolen Body Story (Crazy Claims-Pt 4)</u>

(Thursology Live! 4/14/22)

--The preposterous claims of Jesus of Nazareth:

--I AM the Great I AM...and...I AM the Messiah.

--Week 1: The astronomical mathematics

--The likelihood that Jesus could have fulfilled *just ten* of the prophecies...is as likely as winning a state lottery *three* times in a row...*without losing in between*!!!

--Week 2: Messiah had to thread the historical needle

--Messiah had to be <u>born</u>...<u>before</u> AD 7...to fulfill Gen 49 (The Scepter)!!!

--Messiah had to <u>die</u>...after AD 7...to be crucified (rather than stoned)!!!

--Messiah had to <u>die</u>...<u>before</u> AD 70...to fulfill Daniel 9 (Messiah would be cut off before the Temple was destroyed)...and because the genealogies were destroyed when the Temple was leveled...thus making it forever-after impossible to verify <u>any</u> would-be Messiah's lineage!!!

--Week 3: An OT threat to Jesus' Messiahship: Joseph's sons could not reign as Israel's king

--<u>Problem #1</u>: The *persistent* unfaithfulness of <u>Solomon</u> and his descendants.

--<u>Problem #2</u>: Jeremiah's specific *disqualification* of *Jeconiah and his descendants*

--The resolution:

--<u>Mary's</u> lineage comes directly from <u>David's</u>...through his son Nathan...<u>bypassing</u> Solomon and Jeconiah...and keeping Jesus' kingly and Messianic lineage intact!!!

--The Centrality of the Resurrection

--<u>Rev 14:13</u>: And I heard a voice from heaven, saying..."<u>Blessed are the dead</u> who die in the Lord"

--<u>The "Passover Plot</u>"

--<u>The "Plot</u>": Jesus attempted to <u>authenticate</u> Himself as the <u>MESSIAH</u> by deliberately <u>ACTING</u> out the Old Testament prophecies.

--How could Jesus have possibly pulled this off???

--<u>Prophecy #1</u>: The method of His execution was prophesied at least eight <u>CENTURIES</u> before crucifixion was even <u>INVENTED</u>

--<u>Psalm 22:16</u>: For dogs have surrounded me; a band of evildoers has encompassed me; <u>they pierced my hands and my feet</u>.

--<u>Prophecy #2</u>: In the midst of the crucifixion...they would cast <u>LOTS</u> for His <u>CLOTHS</u> --<u>Psalm 22:18</u>: They divide my garments among them, and <u>for my clothing they cast lots</u>

--<u>Prophecy #3</u>: They would give Him vinegar and gall to **DRINK**

--<u>Psalm 69:21</u>: They also gave me gall for my food and for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

--<u>Prophecy #4</u>: His grave was <u>assigned</u> with <u>WICKED</u> men...and yet...supposedly He was also going to end up with a <u>RICH</u> man in His death???

--<u>Isa 53:9a, b</u>: His grave was assigned with <u>wicked</u> men, yet He was with a <u>rich</u> man in His death...

--<u>A ridiculously difficult combination of prophecies to fulfill</u>: Jesus died with <u>THIEVES</u>...and yet...He was buried in the <u>PRIVATE</u> tomb of Joseph of Arimathea!!!

--Some really telling questions:

--<u>Question #1</u>: Can anyone actually conceive of <u>*Roman soldiers*</u> being part of a <u>**PLOT**</u>...and <u>**INTENTIONALLY**</u> helping to act out the applicable <u>**PROPHECIES**</u>???

--<u>Question #2</u>: Even if He <u>had</u> the money for a <u>BRIBE</u>...how could Jesus have known <u>which</u> soldiers would be <u>ASSIGNED</u> to the cross so He could pay them in <u>ADVANCE</u>???

--<u>Question #3</u>: Can any <u>unbiased</u> person conceive that Judas <u>DESTROYED</u> himself to deceive the Jews into following a <u>FAKE</u> Messiah???

--<u>An incredibly easy way to disqualify Jesus</u>: All that the rabbis had to do to **DESTROY** Jesus' messianic claim was to pay Judas <u>31</u> pieces of silver instead of 30. (Zech 11:10-12)

--<u>An amazing paradox</u>: The actions of the people who most wanted to <u>DISCREDIT</u> Jesus...ended up providing the most powerful <u>PROOFS</u> that Jesus was <u>EXACTLY</u> Who He said He was.

--Two irreconcilable accounts of what happened after Jesus' death:

--<u>1st account</u>: The <u>**RESURRECTION**</u> of Jesus

--<u>I Cor 15:3-8</u>: 3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, 5 and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. 6 After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep; 7 then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles; 8 and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also.

---<u>Rom 10:8-9</u>: But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart <u>that God raised Him from the dead</u>, you will be saved...

--<u>2nd Account</u>: The Disciples <u>STOLE</u> the <u>BODY</u>

--<u>Matt 28:11-15</u>: Now while they were on their way, some of <u>the guard</u> came into the city and <u>reported to the chief priests all that had happened</u>. And when they had assembled with the elders and consulted together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers, and said, "<u>You are to say, 'His disciples came by night and stole Him away while we</u> <u>were asleep</u>.' And if this should come to the governor's ears, we will win him over and keep you out of trouble." And they took the money and did as they had been instructed; <u>and this story was widely spread among the Jews, and is to this day</u>.

--<u>The Heresy</u>: Easter is simply <u>SYMBOLIC</u> of Christ being <u>victorious</u>...and a resurrection of Jesus' <u>BODY</u> is...<u>UNNECESSARY</u>

--<u>The Biblical Foundation</u>: In Scripture...the bodily resurrection is treated as the <u>SINGLE</u> event upon which Christianity <u>STANDS</u> or <u>FALLS</u>!!!

--<u>I Cor 15:12-19</u>: Now if Christ is preached, that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? But if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised; and if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, your faith also is vain. Moreover we are even found to be false witnesses of God, because we testified against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised. For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised; and if Christ has not been raised. For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised; and if Christ has not been raised, *your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins*. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, *we are of all men most to be pitied*.

--<u>The "Stolen Body" story</u>:

--<u>An unassailable historical fact</u>: That the authorities had <u>every</u> reason to <u>DISPLAY</u> the body...but didn't...and that the tomb was verifiably <u>EMPTY</u>...is a matter of historic record by <u>ALL</u> accounts!!!

--<u>The biggest missed opportunity in history</u>: Those with a vested interest in the "Jesus-is-alive Problem" *going away*...missed their chance to **INVALIDATE** the **EMPTY** tomb!!!

--<u>The Disciple Fact</u>: If we know <u>nothing else</u> about the Disciples…we know that they were <u>COWARDS</u> of the <u>HIGHEST</u> order!!!

--<u>An irreconcilable disqualification for the veracity of the "Stolen Body Story</u>": The Roman soldiers had <u>ALL</u> fallen <u>ASLEEP</u>...and yet...they <u>KNEW</u> who had <u>TAKEN</u> the body

--Irrefutable arguments against the "conspiracy theory":

--<u>Counter-apologetic #1</u>: A conspiracy would never have had <u>WOMEN</u> be the <u>DISCOVERERS</u> of the risen Christ!!!

--<u>Counter-apologetic #2</u>: When the resurrection was reported to the <u>DISCIPLES</u>...they were actually <u>DUMBFOUNDED</u>!!!

--Luke 24:1-22a, 25-27, 31, 33-34, 36-44

--<u>One of the most remarkable and telling statements in all of Scripture</u>: "...the other women with them were telling these things to the apostles. But <u>these words</u> appeared to them as <u>NONSENSE</u>, and they would not <u>BELIEVE</u> them."

--<u>Counter-apologetic #3</u>: The greatest <u>SKEPTIC</u>...became the most convincing <u>WITNESS</u>!!!

--<u>Who was the greatest skeptic in all of history</u>? \rightarrow "Doubting" Thomas

--John 20:19-20, 24-28: So when it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and when the doors were shut where the disciples were, *for fear of the Jews*, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." And when He had said this, He showed them both His hands and His side. The disciples then rejoiced when they saw the Lord...But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "*Unless I see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe*." After eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then He said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing." Thomas answered and said to Him, "*My Lord and my God*!"

--<u>The great gift of Thomas's doubt</u>: The **PROOF** of the **BODILY** resurrection of Jesus Christ

--The most powerful evidence for the resurrection:

--<u>One of the greatest surprises in all of Christian apologetics</u>: The <u>MOST</u> powerful authenticating evidence for the Resurrection...<u>didn't</u> come while He was still <u>WITH</u> the Disciples...but after He was <u>GONE</u>!!!

--<u>The greatest witness of history</u>: After Jesus <u>LEFT</u> them...the previously-<u>COWARDLY</u> Disciples...went on to courageously <u>DIE</u> for their witness of the Resurrection!!!

--<u>The key difference</u>: Lots of people have died for <u>FALSE</u> causes that they believe are <u>TRUE</u>...but <u>no one</u> dies for a cause that they <u>know</u> is <u>FALSE</u>!!!

--<u>The unassailable verification of The Resurrection</u>: A tiny band of cowardly, brokenhearted, disillusioned followers of a <u>DEAD</u> and <u>DEFUNCT</u> rabbi…became fearless, unshakable, undaunted, courageous <u>MARTYRS</u> as a direct result of <u>DEFENDING</u>…*this very story*!!!
