Thursology 93: The Dispute Remains!!! Did God INTENTIONALLY Leave the Timing of the Rapture UNRESOLVED??? (Rapture #16)

--<u>The Big Question</u>: Why would God leave something as _____ the "blessed hope of the church" _____ to such dramatically interpretations???

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--A major point that the Post-Trib advocates make to support their view: The gathering of the "_____" in Matthew 24 clearly happens at the of the Tribulation

--Matt 24:30-31: "...and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of the sky with power and great glory. And He will send forth His angels with a great trumpet and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of the sky to the other."

--The alternative statement in Matthew 24:31 that Jesus could have made that would have established the Post-Trib View as the only possible view:

--- "And He will send forth His angels with a great trumpet and they will gather together His ______ from the four winds, from one end of the sky to the other."

--The entirely reasonable...and very telling question to ask: Why did Jesus use the word ...rather than the word ???

--Why did God leave this incredibly important issue open to so much debate???

--Because this is _____ how He _____ to leave it !!!

--God's Purpose in the Ambiguity:

--<u>Question #1</u>: What is God's purpose for the _____-Trib view to be believed so consistently...by so many Christians...throughout Church history?

--Answer: To emphasize the importance of being for Jesus to

--Matt 24:36-44: "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone. For the coming of the Son of Man will be just like the days of Noah. For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and they did not understand until the flood came and took them all away; so will the coming of the Son of Man be. Then there will be two men in the field; one will be taken and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken and one will be left. "Therefore be on the alert, for you do not know which day your Lord is coming. But be sure of this, that if the head of the house had known at what time of the night the thief was coming, he would have been on the alert and would not have allowed his house to be broken into. For this reason you also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think He will.

--The bottom line of the Pre-Trib View: Be to be...______!!!

--<u>Matt 24:45-51</u>: Who then is the faithful and sensible slave whom his master put in charge of his household to give them their food at the proper time? Blessed is that slave whom his master finds so doing when he comes. Truly I say to you that he will put him in charge of all his possessions. But if that evil slave says in his heart, 'My master is not coming for a long time,' and begins to beat his fellow slaves and eat and drink with drunkards; the master of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour which he does not know, and will cut him in pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

--<u>Question #2</u>: What is God's purpose for the _____-Trib view to be believed so consistently...by so many Christians...throughout Church history?

--<u>Answer</u>: To emphasize the importance of ______... and being ______ to _____ for Christ...and even to ______

--<u>Matt 24:6-13</u>: You will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not frightened, for those things must take place, but that is not yet the end. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and in various places there will be famines and earthquakes. But all these things are merely the beginning of birth pangs. <u>Then they will deliver you to tribulation, and will kill you, and you will be hated by all nations because of My name. At that time many will fall away and will betray one another and hate one another.</u> Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many. Because lawlessness is increased, most people's love will grow cold. 13 <u>But the one who endures to the end, he will be saved</u>.

--<u>The bottom line of the POST-Trib View</u>: Be ______ to be...

--<u>I Pet 4:7, 12-16, 19</u>: *The end of all things is near*; therefore, be of sound judgment and sober spirit for the purpose of prayer...Beloved, <u>do not be</u> <u>surprised at the fiery ordeal among you</u>, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you; <u>but to the degree that you</u> <u>share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing, so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation</u>. If you are reviled <u>for the name of Christ</u>, you are <u>blessed</u>, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. Make sure that none of you suffers as a murderer, or thief, or evildoer, or a troublesome meddler; <u>but if anyone suffers as a Christian, he is not to be ashamed, but is to glorify God</u> in this name...Therefore, those also who suffer <u>according to the will</u> <u>of God</u> shall entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing what is right.

--<u>The Appropriate Response</u>: Be prepared to _____... be prepared for _____...and do not _____ of sharing in Christ's ______!!!

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--<u>Vv. 12-13</u>: On the next day the large crowd who had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took the branches of the palm trees and went out to meet Him, and began to shout, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel."

--<u>Vv. 14-18</u>: Jesus, finding a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written, "Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your King is coming, seated on a donkey's colt." <u>These things His</u> <u>disciples did not understand</u> at the first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written of Him, and that they had done these things to Him. So the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead, continued to testify about Him. For this reason also the people went and met Him, <u>because they heard that He had performed this sign</u>.



The Major Events of the Tribulation

<u>Thursology 92: Post-Trib Weaknesses:</u> Jesus Can't Return...TODAY??? (Rapture #15)

(Thursology Live! 10/6/22)

--The Post-Tribulational Rapture View: Jesus Returns at the End of the Seven Years:

--<u>Key Concept</u>: If the <u>*Pre*</u>-Trib View is right...then the Church will be <u>*removed*</u> before the <u>**HORRORS**</u> of the Tribulation...but if the <u>*Post*</u>-Trib View is correct...believers of the last generation will <u>**EXPERIENCE**</u> them...and multitudes will <u>**DIE**</u> from refusing to take <u>*The Mark*!!!</u>

--The problems and challenges with the Post-Trib View:

--<u>Problem #1</u>: The Post-Trib Rapture would be the most <u>ANTICLIMACTIC</u> event in <u>HISTORY</u>

--<u>Corollary</u>: If believers go <u>THROUGH</u> the Tribulation...then the Last Days seem much more about Antichrist <u>KILLING</u> the Church...than Christ <u>SAVING</u> them!!!

--<u>Problem #2</u>: If the Rapture comes at the <u>END</u> of the Tribulation...how can this be a <u>COMFORT</u> to believers???

--<u>I Thess 4:15-18</u>: For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord. <u>Therefore comfort one another</u> <u>with these words</u>.

--<u>Problem #3</u>: It's difficult to see how this view passes the "<u>BLESSED</u> hope <u>TEST</u>"

--<u>Titus 2:11-13</u>: For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all, instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, looking for <u>the blessed hope</u> and <u>the appearing of the glory of our great</u> <u>God and Savior</u>, Christ Jesus.

---<u>Problem #4</u>: The <u>number</u> of long-awaited prophetic promises that have to be fulfilled in one <u>BRIEF</u> event is difficult to <u>comprehend</u>...and this requirement seems to <u>TRIVIALIZE</u> some of the most important events that will ever occur

--<u>Corollary</u>: If the Post-Trib View is right...here are the events that must all be "<u>crammed</u>" into no more than a <u>single</u> day:

--Christ APPEARS in the air

--The dead saints are **RESURRECTED**

--The living saints are CHANGED

- --The Church MEETS Him in the air
- --The JUDGMENT Seat of Christ
- --The MARRIAGE Supper of the Lamb

--<u>Rev 19:7-9</u>: Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to God, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His bride has made herself ready. It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. Then he said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb."

--After the Supper...Christ gathers His <u>ARMIES</u> of saints and angels

--He **<u>DESCENDS</u>** with His armies to fight the Battle of Armageddon

--He CONQUERS the armies of ANTICHRIST

--<u>Problem #5</u>: With the Post-Trib View...it's difficult to keep imminency <u>INTACT</u> without <u>ALLEGORIZING</u> the Revelation events that will happen before Christ returns

--<u>Rev 6:7-8</u>: One fourth of humanity dies

--<u>Rev 8:6-7</u>: One third of the vegetation on the earth is burned up

--Rev 9:13-16: One third of the survivors of humanity die

--<u>Rev 10:3, 5-6</u>: The two witnesses prophesy for 1260 days...and fire comes out of their mouth and devours their enemies...and they stop the rain from falling for 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ years

--<u>Rev 13:11, 16-17</u>: Humanity forced to take the Mark to be able to buy or sell

--<u>Rev 14:6-7</u>: An angel preaches the Gospel from the heavens to every nation and tribe and tongue and people

--<u>Rev 16:17-18, 21</u>: A great global earthquake that's nothing like anything in history...and 100-pound hailstones fall on the earth

--<u>Key Concept</u>: Revelation tells us that there will be exactly <u>1260</u> days from the signing of the Peace Treaty until the Abomination of Desolation…and then exactly <u>1260</u> days from the Abomination until Christ <u>RETURNS</u> at Armageddon

--<u>A Key Question for the Post-Trib View</u>: Since the Peace Treaty, the Abomination, and Armageddon have specifically <u>TIMED</u> sequencing...if the Rapture of the Church occurs simultaneously with Armageddon...then how could the church <u>NOT</u> know which day the Lord will <u>RETURN</u>???

--<u>Key Concept #1</u>: The Church has <u>always</u> believed that Jesus can return for His <u>Bride</u> at <u>any</u> time --<u>Key Concept #2</u>: This means that...whatever your view...the timing of the *Rapture* must be a *surprise*

--<u>A big question for the Post-Trib View</u>: Since many easily-identifiable events **PRECEDE** Christ's 2nd Coming at the end of the Tribulation...if the Rapture and the 2nd Coming are part of the **SAME** event...how could the Rapture be a **SURPRISE**???

--Post-Trib Problems:

--<u>Problem #1</u>: At the end of a long string of clearly-prophesied and specifically-<u>TIMED</u> global cataclysmic events...how could everyone...including the <u>Church</u>...be caught <u>SLUMBERING</u> when the very Day of the Bridegroom's return would be absolutely <u>PREDICTABLE</u>?

--<u>Problem #2</u>: It's really hard to square the "<u>SNATCHED</u> away" Rapture passages with the Post-Trib view...since this event will occur exactly <u>2520</u> days after the signing of the Peace Treaty and exactly <u>1260</u> days after the Treaty is broken...and thus...a person could <u>KNOW</u> the day of Christ's return

--<u>The greatest strength of the Pre-Trib View</u>: In the Pre-Trib Rapture timing...<u>NOTHING</u> has to happen <u>BEFORE</u> Jesus returns for His Church...keeping perfectly intact the Doctrine of Imminency...that Christ can return at any <u>MOMENT</u>...and that no one can <u>KNOW</u> the Day!!!

--<u>Problem #6</u>: In the Post-Trib timing...since the Church goes <u>through</u> the Tribulation...it appears that <u>BELIEVERS</u> experience God's <u>WRATH</u>

--<u>Rev 16:1</u>: Then I heard a loud voice from the temple, saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the *wrath of God*."

--<u>I Thess 5:9</u>: "For <u>God has not destined us for wrath</u>, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ..."

--<u>Application #1</u>: Because of God's amazing <u>grace</u>...while we <u>do</u> receive His <u>DISCIPLINE</u>...we will <u>never</u> experience His <u>WRATH</u>!!!

--<u>Application #2</u>: If you've truly <u>REPENTED</u> and...through the work of the Holy Spirit <u>TURNED</u> from your sin...then...residual <u>GUILT</u> is <u>not</u> from God!!!

--The Enemy has two diametrically-opposed weapons when it comes to guilt:

--<u>Weapon #1</u>: To those who are living with <u>SIN</u> in their life...he <u>SOOTHS</u> and <u>DAMPENS</u> the conscience

--<u>Weapon #2</u>: To those who've been *truly forgiven*...he makes a relentless attempt to create **FALSE** guilt...and **SELF**-condemnation

--<u>I John 1:9</u>: If we confess or sins, He is faithful and righteous and <u>will</u> forgive us of our sins, and <u>cleanse</u> us from <u>all</u> unrighteousness.

--Freedom from guilt...and empowered to live for Christ:

---<u>Hebrews 4:16</u>: Therefore let us draw near with <u>confidence</u> to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

--<u>I John 2:28</u>: Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have <u>confidence</u> and <u>not shrink away</u> from Him in <u>shame</u> at His coming.

--<u>Romans 8:1</u>: Therefore there is now <u>*no condemnation*</u> for those who are <u>*in*</u> Christ Jesus.

--<u>Hebrews 10:19-23</u>: Therefore, brethren, since we have <u>confidence</u> to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us...and since we have a <u>great</u> high priest over the house of God, let us <u>draw near</u> with a sincere heart in <u>full assurance</u> of faith, having our hearts sprinkled <u>clean</u> from an evil conscience and our bodies <u>washed</u> with <u>pure</u> water. Let us <u>hold fast</u> the confession of our hope <u>without wavering</u>, for He who promised <u>is faithful</u>..."
